A seminar on "Law School Skills Training: Negotiation, ADR and Clinical Experience" was held in Prime University in association with Loyola Law School of Los Angeles on July, 23rd, 2011. The main speaker of this seminar was Mr. Hiro N. Aragaki, Professor of the center for conflict resolution of Loyola Law School. The Chief guest of the seminar was Vice Chancellor of Prime University Professor Dr. Profulla C. Sarker. The seminar was chaired by Dr. Uttam Kumar Das, Advisor of the Department of Law of the University. Professor Mohammad Arshad Ali, Registrar of the University, Professor Dr. Abdul

Mannan Sardar, Dean, Faculty of Engineering, Chairmen of different departments, faculty members, Executives and students of Law departments were also present.

In his speech Professor Hiro N. Aragaki said that Law departments can play a vital role in alternative dispute resolution (ADR). PU Observed National Mourning Day 2011

Prime University observed August 15 as the National Mourning Day to mark the 36th anniversary of the martyrdom of the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman with due respect and solemnity at its premises.

The day long program started with the hoisting of the national flag at half-mast atop the university building along with black flag reflecting the sign of grief. Faculty members, students and officers of PU observed the day by wearing black badges and holding a special discussion session and Milad & Doa-Mahfil to pay homage to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, who was brutally assassinated along with most of the members of his family on the fateful night of August 15, 1975.

Professor Profulla Chandra Sarker, Vice Chancellor of Prime University presided over the discussion session. Among others, M. Moniruzzaman, Senior Vice-Chairman, Board of Trustees, Md. Ashraf Ali, Vice-Chairman, Board of Trustees, Mir Shahabuddin, Member Secretary, Board of Trustees, Prof. M. Abdus Sobhan, Member, Board of Trustees, Prof. Dr. Abdul Mannan Sardar, Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Professor Mohammad Arshad Ali, Registrar of the university, Prof. A.N.M. Mourning for Mirsarai and Tareque Masud-Mishuk Munier Road Accidents

An alarming number of road accidents occur every day in our country. All road accidents are despondent but some are more despondent and bring heartbreaking misery to the victim's family as well as in the whole country. Two such accidents: Tragic Mirsarai road accident and Tareque Masud-Mishuk Munier road accident happened some days ago. In Mirsarai accident, at least 43 boys were killed and 12 more injured when a truck carrying them plunged into a ditch at Mirsarai upazila on July 11, 2011. Forty-one of the deceased were school goers and the other two were college students. The students and teachers of Prime University wore black badges and displayed banners to mourn the death of the Mirsarai students. In another road accident, internationally acclaimed filmmaker Tareque Masud and chief executive officer of ATN News Ashfaq Munier Mishuk were killed when their microbus collided with a passenger bus on the Dhaka-Aricha highway in Ghior upazila of Manikganj on August 13, 2011. Special prayer was held in Prime University seeking eternal peace of the departed souls and conveying sympathy to the bereaved members of both families.
