Highlights of 2021-2022

Mock Trial and Court Visit

The Department of Law is required under the Clinical Legal Education course to arrange a mock trial (a simulation of a real trial) and a court visit for the LLB program students. The 46th batch of students' classmates participated in a mock trial on January 19, 2022, as part of that usual practice. The judge in the trial was Syed Mohammad Rezwanaul Islam, an assistant professor in the Department. The trial was attended by the law department's entire faculty, who were impressed by the students' outstanding legal abilities as the trial's advocates. The children received a lot of praise for their outstanding performance during the trial. The same batch of pupils had previously attended the Dhaka Judges' Court on January 6, 2022. The students were guided by Golam Sarowar, an assistant professor in the Department, who demonstrated various judicial proceedings for them, including a live trial and oral arguments. Additionally, they went to the court's GR section, record room, and legal assistance office, where the students learned about various legal issues and procedures.

Orientation Program in the Department of Law

The Department of Law organized an orientation program for the incoming admissions (59th Batch) of students. The pupils are cordially welcomed to the program at the outset. The purpose was to introduce the students to the Department's curriculum and instructional techniques. All of the Department's instructors provided guidelines and informed the students of the university's policies. The Head of the Department, Dr. Abdullah Al-Monzur Hussain gave

a speech outlining the goal of the initiative. The ceremony was wrapped up with prayers for the university's safety and success. After attending the orientation event, the kids felt upbeat.

Eid Reunion and View Exchange Meetings in the Department of Law

On May 22 and January 2, 2021, the law department at Prime University hosted a virtual Eid reunion event. The session was attended by a sizable number of students from various batches (LLB Hons and LLM). Prof. Dr. Mohammad Arshad Ali, the Dean of the Faculty, attended the virtual meeting as the Chief Guest. At the same time, Dr. Abdullah Al-Monzur Hussain, the Head of the Department, presided over the proceedings. The event's chief guest expressed optimism for eradicating the Covid-19 pandemic so that the Eid reunion program might be held on campus physically the following year. Seminars/Webinars Organized in the Department of Law

Webinar on "Women Rights in Digital Age: Bangladesh Perspective": On September 5, 2021, the Department of Law presented a webinar on "Women Rights in Digital Age: Bangladesh Perspective" in association with the University's Center for Research, Human Resource Development, and Publications. The webinar largely focused on women's rights in the digital era, including shortcomings and appropriate solutions. Senior Lecturer Sayed Mohammad Rezwanaul Islam served as the session's moderator and delivered the opening remarks. As the webinar's Chairperson, Dr. Abdullah-Al-Monzur Hussain, Head of the Department of Law oversaw the event. As the session's Chief Guest and Special Guest, respectively, Md. Ashraf Ali, the esteemed Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Prime University, and Professor M. Jahangir Alam, Vice Chancellor of the University, thoughtfully decorated the gathering. Md. Ashraf Ali discussed the government's responsibility for upholding and defending women's rights in Bangladesh. Professor M. Jahangir Alam said that Prime University would proactively support any initiative to advance and defend women's rights. The webinar's keynote speaker, Barrister Nawrose M. R. Chowdhury of the Bangladesh Supreme Court, an attorney and deputy attorney general, focused on the connection between women's rights and digitization from the perspective of Bangladesh. He stressed how, in the present era, the technology significantly impacts women's lives, movements, and rights. He offered several suggestions and underlined the need for laws protecting

women's rights in Bangladesh in the digital age. Teachers and students enthusiastically participated in the question-and-answer session during the webinar's latter portion.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

Overview:

The Department of English at Prime University is one of the live Departments belonging to the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. The Department started its journey in 2002 in order to impart the knowledge of English language and literature at the tertiary level. The academic activities of this Department are conducted by the faculty members who have excellent academic knowledge and experience. The department offers BA (Hons) and MA programs. There are two main academic streams in the Department: Literature and Applied Linguistics/ English Language Teaching (ELT). The syllabus of the Literature stream of the Department of English contains a range of literary writings in English from different historical periods and geographical regions. Literary texts are read in juxtaposition with theoretical approaches to literature and culture, inculcating the spirit of inquiry and analysis amongst students. On the other hand, the Applied Linguistics/ELT stream of the Department studies the place of language in society as well as imparts basic teaching skills to students based on theories of language learning and acquisition. The post-graduate program consists of MA program either in Literature or Applied Linguistics/ELT. The Literature stream involves a more comprehensive approach based on theories i.e. post-colonial, feminist, Marxist, postmodern approaches to literature. The Applied Linguistics/ELT stream concentrates on the practical and theoretical skills together. The concentration on technological approaches to language learning and acquisition is to equip all students with writing, research and analytical skills.

The Objective of the Bachelor of Education (BEd) Program:

The objective of the program is to develop human quality and trained human resource for different disciplines of Education through comprehensive teacher education and training following appropriate course curriculum. The major objectives of this program are to provide:

- i. Modern fundamental courses in education for developing professional competencies based on in-depth knowledge, relevant skills and values along with ethical and cultural orientation;
- ii. Practical experiences of performing professional responsibilities in actual situations through attachment program in educational institutions; and
- iii. Sound foundation is required for further professional study in education leading to specialization in a specific area of education

Master of Education (MEd):

The MEd program is a 1-year program consisting of 3 semesters. The academic semesters start in February, June and October each year. Each semester consists of 13 weeks for teaching, including 1 week for preparation for the examination and a further 2 weeks for examination. The whole program has 36 credits.
